Attorney Population Density by Metropolitan Statistical Area¹ Report: 2005-06

This report shows the concentration of active attorneys licensed by the State Bar of Texas by county for all 25 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) and Non-Metropolitan Areas as of Bar fiscal year 2005-06. This concentration is expressed as a ratio of attorneys to the general population. It is also shown as a percent of total in-state bar membership. For context, the county population is given both as a number and as a percent of the total Texas population.
