Tarrant County: Attorney Statistical Profile (2016-17)

This report profiles active Tarrant County attorney members with membership in the State Bar of Texas as of December 31, 2016. Not all demographic data is provided by every attorney. Separate population totals are provided in italics in each category that is lacking all demographic data. Percentages may not sum to one hundred due to rounding. Over the last 10 years the number of Tarrant County attorneys has increased by 32 percent, growing from 5,370 attorneys in 2006 to 4,060 in 2016.
