HARDSHIP WAIVER OF MEMBERSHIP DUES REQUEST FORM

The State Bar of Texas, upon receipt of the following items, may waive some or all of the membership dues of any member who demonstrates undue hardship. **The legal services fee mandated by Section 81.054(j), Government Code, may not be waived.**

Undue hardship exists when a member is unable to pay membership dues because of illness, disability, or other extraordinary circumstances beyond the member's control.

To request a waiver, a member must, by August 31 of each year in which a waiver is requested, remit to the State Bar:

- Hardship Waiver of Membership Fees Request Form;
- A written statement outlining the circumstances upon which the request for waiver of dues is based (Please do not send medical records);
- A written statement by the member - either sworn to before a notary or made under penalty of perjury - averring that the circumstances, upon which the request is based, are beyond the member's control and the direct cause of the member's inability to pay membership dues.
