**2021 Proposed Legislation Relating to the Anatomical Gift Act and  
Revised Uniform Anatomical Gift Act**

1. Section 1 of the proposed bill amends Section 692A.005, Health and Safety Code, to permit a statement of anatomical gift to be acknowledged in the presence of a notary public in lieu of being witnessed by two adults.
2. Section 2 of the proposed bill amends Section 692A.006, Health and Safety Code, to permit a revocation of a statement of anatomical gift to be acknowledged in the presence of a notary public in lieu of being witnessed by two adults.
3. Section 3 of the proposed bill amends Section 692A.007, Health and Safety Code, to permit a refusal to make an anatomical gift to be acknowledged in the presence of a notary public in lieu of being witnessed by two adults.
4. Section 4 of the proposed bill repeals Chapter 692, Health and Safety Code, which was replaced by Chapter 692A, effective September 1, 2009.

REPTL has received no statements of position on these proposed changes, and has submitted these proposals to all sections and committees of the State Bar of Texas, as required by its Legislative Policy. If any comments are received, they will be forwarded to the State Bar.
