

Order Amending Article XII of the State Bar Rules


ORDERED that:

 - d. submit a copy of this Order for publication in the *Texas Register*.



**ARTICLE XII
TEXAS MINIMUM CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION**

Section 11. Exemption of Certain Judges and Judicial Officers

~~Judges subject to Supreme Court Order for Judicial Education dated August 21, 1985, Supreme Court Order for Judicial Education for Retired or Former District Judges dated July 2, 1986, and federal judicial officers, shall be~~The following are exempt from these MCLE requirements:

- judges, including retired and former judges subject to assignment and justices of the peace, required to complete instruction under the Rules of Judicial Education, adopted by the Texas Court of Criminal Appeals;
- judicial officers, as defined in Rule 4(d) of the Rules of Judicial Education; and
- federal judges.
