### **Daniel O'Neil** **for District 4, Place 2**

Daniel is Counsel in the Products, Pharma, Medical, and Mass Tort Disputes group at Norton Rose Fulbright US LLP. Mayor Turner proclaimed October 1, 2018 “Daniel O’Neil Day” in the City of Houston, honoring his history of volunteer service lifting up and supporting the community’s most vulnerable and disaster impacted families. Daniel is Fellow of the Texas Bar Foundation, sustaining member of the SBOT Litigation Section, annual member of the *Pro Bono* & State Bar Colleges, and one of the earliest enrolled Equal Access to Justice Society members. Committed to ensuring equal access to justice for all, Daniel is the only lawyer in private practice designated a “Probate Master” by the Houston Volunteer Lawyers. The Houston Bar Foundation presented Daniel with the Outstanding Small Firm Contribution Award to the Houston Volunteer Lawyers for his *pro bono* service—earning Equal Access to Justice Grand Champion honors—for bar year 2017. Daniel spent the past year as co-chair of HYLAs CLE Committee advancing his programmatic emphasis to deliver new and diverse voices on critical topics facing young lawyers. As a first generation lawyer, Daniel intends to bring the same emphasis to the Directorship in promoting new and diverse District 4 voices.
