Andrew Tolchin began practicing law in 2000 and presently mediates at 713 Mediator, LLC. Andrew founded Texas Lawyers (TL), a digital bar association which enables over 14,000 Texas-licensed attorneys to communicate with and mentor one another about case strategy, practice management, and legal issues. Andrew served as an elected Director of the State Bar of Texas (2015-2018), as Chair of the Board's Technology Oversight Committee (2018), and as a member of the Board's Nominations and Elections Committee (2017-18). In recognition of his accomplishments, Andrew received both the Judge Sam Williams Award and the Chair of the Board's Outstanding Third Year Director Award in 2018. Andrew has served as a Texas Bar Foundation Nominations co-Chair and is also a Sustaining Life Fellow. He also serves on the Council of the ADR Section and as administrator of a variety of online attorney groups. Andrew graduated from Vassar College in 1995 with a degree in Political Science, and received his J.D. from South Texas College of Law in 1999. He resides in Lake Jackson with his wife, Katie, and their son, Ari.
