Robert L. Tobey for District 6, Place 2

Robert Tobey is the Immediate Past President of the Dallas Bar Association. Robert practices principally in the areas of business litigation and professional liability and is board-certified in Consumer and Commercial Law by the Texas Board of Legal Specialization. Born and raised in Dallas, Robert graduated from the Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania and the University of Texas Law School. He has practiced in Dallas with Randy Johnston since 1987, and now practices in the firm Johnston Tobey Baruch PC. Robert served as President of the Dallas Bar Association during one of the most difficult years in its history. Yet the association emerged stronger than ever. In particular the DBA made substantial progress under Robert's leadership in promoting diversity, equity, inclusion and belonging—including the formation of a new Committee for Equality and granting the Dallas LGBT Bar Association an advisory seat on the DBA Board. Robert served as Co-Chair of the DBA's 2015 Equal Access to Justice Campaign, the first to raise more than \$1,000,000. Robert is a frequent speaker for the State Bar of Texas and currently serves as a Course Director for the Advanced Civil Trial Course. He has been married to JoAnn for 30 years, and has two children, Morgan (27) and Brandon (22).
