Your time of service is over... now it's time to go home. We understand that coming home can be difficult. Some veterans feel alone when dealing with:

We are here to help. The Community Justice Program (CJP) and Texas RioGrande Legal Aid (TRLA) have collaborated to create a monthly legal clinic for veterans. The CJP Veterans Legal Clinics serve low-income veterans in an advice-only setting about a wide variety of legal issues. This clinic can also prepare wills for veterans. During the clinics, pre-qualified veterans can meet one-on-one with a volunteer attorney. They can help you understand legal documents, navigate the legal system, find resources and help get you back on track. Just tell us what you need and we will help.

Our volunteer attorneys practice in all areas of the law and will be on hand at each Veterans Legal Clinic to provide you with advice, guidance and direction. Our attorneys will take the time to listen to you.

ABOUT THE COMMUNITY JUSTICE PROGRAM

The Community Justice Program (CJP) is a collaborative effort by Texas RioGrande Legal Aid (TRLA) and the entire legal community, working together to increase access to justice by bringing legal resources to the community. The CJP holds monthly Veterans, Family Law and Wills Clinics at various locations throughout San Antonio.

The monthly Family Law clinics provide complete legal services for uncontested civil matters (mostly simple, uncontested divorces). Volunteers include attorneys, district clerks, notaries, interpreters, support staff, and judges. The quarterly Wills Clinics provide wills and ancillary documents for individuals who qualify.

How do I qualify for assistance?

The CJP's mission is to provide access to justice for **low-income veterans** and residents in our community.

In order to qualify for the Veterans Legal Clinic, you must complete an intake and screening process prior to the clinic. The clinics serve low-income veterans and their families, and we encourage individuals to call and determine their eligibility.
